
Where to get kids books for low or no cost?

Local Library



- Check out your local library first as it has the biggest selection of kid's books.
- Many library systems are also part of a larger lending library system and provide access to online services such as <u>Hoopla</u> and <u>Overdrive</u>. These just require you to have a library card!







- You can certainly purchase books online at full price from major retailers like Amazon, Barnes & Noble, etc., but there are also discounted books sellers that offer deep discounts on used books with low to no shipping.

Through your local library, you probably have access to at least one of these online book resources. In fact, Hoopla and Overdrive are probably the most popular services offered by your library.

- YouTube and YouTube Kids: You may need to view a few before you find one that is a food fit for you and your bird.
- <u>Overdrive</u>: Enjoy eBooks and audiobooks for free through your local public library or school. Libby is the app to use once you are established with Overdrive (<u>https://libbyapp.com</u>)
 <u>Hoopla</u>: You can create an account or access via your Library Card.
 <u>Storyline Online</u>: The SAG-AFTRA Foundation's Daytime Emmy®-nominated and award-winning
- children's literacy website streams videos featuring celebrated actors reading children's books alongside creatively produced illustrations.
- Free Kids Books: Free Kids Books is a growing library of unique children's books and other resources for children available online and for download in pdf format.
 <u>Cloud Library</u>: Online lending library that does require a Library Card.
 <u>Oxford Owl</u>: Books and activities provided by Oxford Press. Phonics/reading driven.
 <u>Barnes & Noble Free Kids eBooks</u>: Requires the FREE NOOK Reading App for your smartphone or tablet.
