### Dinosaur Name Crafts

These versatile name crafts can be a great intro and decoration for Dinosaur Week! If you are working with sight words or letters of the alphabet, names are a great way to integrate with this theme.

#### Name-a-Saur

- 1. Print out the baby dinosaur on light colored paper or cardstock.
- 2. Cut out the baby dino.
- 3. Use a marker to write your bird's name on the dinosaur's belly.

# Dinosaur Footprint Banner (based on idea from Sandbox Academy)




- 1. Print out one Dino Footprint for each letter of your bird's name on light-colored paper or cardstock.
- 2. Cut out the Footprints and write one letter of your bird's name on each Footprint.
- 3. Cut a length of string or thin ribbon long enough to fit each footprint. Make a hanging loop at the top.
- 4. Glue the footprints to the string and hang.

### Dino Name Dangler

- 1. Print out the baby dinosaur on light colored paper or cardstock and cut out.
- 2. Print out one Dino Footprint for each letter of your bird's name on light-colored paper or cardstock and cut each one out.
- 3. Write one letter of your bird's name on each Footprint.
- 4. Cut a length of string or thin ribbon long enough to fit the baby dino and each footprint. Make a hanging loop at the top.
- 5. Glue the footprints to the string and hang.
- 5. Glue the baby dino to the top of a string or ribbon, then glue each footprint below the baby dino spacing the footprints so each letter can be seen.
