

Dinosaur Week: Flat Chillisaurus

The inspiration for the Flat Chillisaurus comes from combining a parrotlet (named Chilli) and a dinosaur (Tyrannosaurus Rex) with inspiration from [The Flat Stanley Project](#).

In the Flat Stanley Project, Flat Stanley gets sent all over the world. The recipients take pictures with Flat Stanley and send their adventures back to the original sender.

Since we only have one week, we can just print out a Chillisaurus and take pictures of him doing activities with your flock during **Dinosaur Week!** Upload your photos to our Facebook group and our MediaFire link.

We have provided two versions of the Chillisaurus – one in color and one in black & white for you to color. Print a Chillisaurus and then cut it out. For ease of handling, glue a popsicle stick, pipe cleaner, or strip of heavy cardboard to the back of him to create a handle.

Take a picture of him doing activities with your Flock and post them for everyone to see!

Important Note: Please ensure your birds are NOT scared of Chillisaurus! Use training methods presented in the Parrot Kindergarten Program to ensure your bird(s) can ‘chill’ with Chillisaurus!

Materials:

- Printer
- Cardstock or white paper
- Scissors
- Glue or tape
- Markers, crayons, or paint (bird-safe, please!)
- Popsicle stick, heavy cardboard strip, or pipe cleaners.

Directions

1. Print out one of the Chillisaurus templates. They will print on a US Letter-sized page (8.5"x11" / 22 x 28 cm)
2. Color if needed.
3. Cut out along the dotted lines.
4. Glue a Popsicle stick, heavy cardboard strip, or pipe cleaner to the back between the legs to create a handle.
5. Pose Chillisaurus with your flock for fun photos! Post to the Parrot Kindergarten Facebook Group or to our MediaFire Link!
